Travel & Competition Policy

At Sarasota All Stars, competitions are an exciting and important part of the All-Star experience. To ensure a positive, organized, and successful environment for all athletes, the following expectations apply to all athletes and families.

Competition Commitment

All athletes selected for a team are expected to attend all scheduled competitions. Competitions are a team commitment, and absences may impact the entire team.

Failure to attend may result in removal from routine sections, changes in team placement, or ineligibility for future events.

Travel Expectations

Families are responsible for arranging their own travel unless otherwise specified.

Athletes must arrive on time for all scheduled practices, warm-ups, and performance times.

Late arrivals may result in removal from the routine for safety reasons.

Some events may require booking within designated team hotel blocks.

Athlete Supervision

Athletes are the responsibility of their parent/guardian unless under direct supervision of a coach during official team activities.

Athletes must remain with their team during all scheduled competition times.

Parents may not enter athlete warm-up or restricted areas unless permitted by event staff.

Behavior Expectations

All athletes and parents are expected to represent Sarasota All Stars with professionalism and respect at all times.

This includes positive sportsmanship, no negative comments, following event rules, and respecting coaches' decisions.

Team Appearance & Spirit

Athletes must arrive on time and prepared for all competition meet times.

Hair and makeup will be completed together as a team at the designated meet time.

Families are encouraged to show team spirit by wearing Sarasota All Stars apparel or team colors.

Jewelry, nails, and other uniform guidelines must be followed as directed for safety and scoring compliance.

Communication During Events

All communication will come from coaches or program leadership.

Parents should avoid approaching coaches immediately before or after performances.

Questions should be addressed at an appropriate time following the event.

Awards & Team Participation

Athletes are expected to stay with their team through awards unless otherwise approved.

Teams will enter and exit awards together.

Social Media

Athletes and parents must represent the program positively online.

Negative posts will not be tolerated.

Policy Enforcement

Failure to follow this policy may result in removal from routines, benching, parent meetings, or removal from the program.
